From the start, it was founded to help bring the country together looking to the end of the American Civil War. President Abraham Lincoln, meeting with several early members, called its purposes most wonderful and supported that its great principles be perpetuated.

Three American presidents were members: William B. McKinley and Warren G. Harding; including Franklin Delano Roosevelt who became a member in the White House, February 19, 1936.

Pythian Awareness Week is the designation for purposes of public promotion and events introducing Our Order and seeking new members. In addition to being non-Sectarian, its membership has included women since August 2019.
